

# COLOUR WHEEL

PRIMARY, SECONDARY AND INTERMEDIATE COLOURS

How to use:

The Colour Wheel helps to find the best colour combinations, based on the geometric relationships between colours.

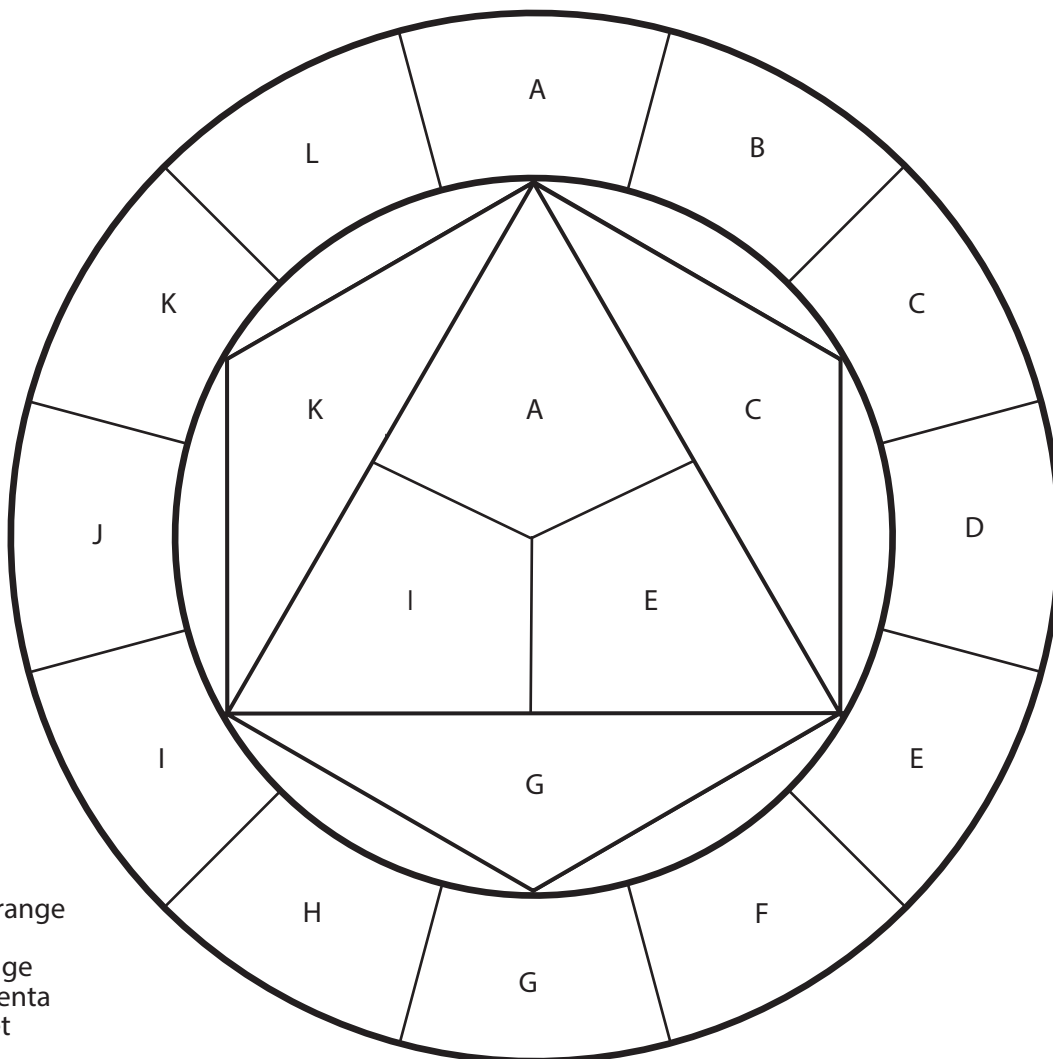
The Wheel is divided in 12 basic hues - 3 primary, 3 secondary and 6 intermediate or tertiary colours.

It shows visually which colours are opposite or close to each other. Complementary colours are opposites on the wheel. Analogous are side by side.

Opposites create contrast, intensity and drama.  
Colours next to each other create harmony, unity and serenity.
